Note 2: Doubles pairings may be formed across all classes. A final grouping will be made by adding the classification scores of the two players involved.

Note 3: Grouping of players into classes 1-2 will be announced no later than August 15th.

ELIGIBILITY

The 2024 NETU Parkinson Table Tennis Championships is open to everyone within the NETU area with Parkinson's disease who provide a medical certificate. After your registration we will send a classification form for you to fill in and send back to us no later than August 1st. All players must accept their classification and answer all questions truthfully.

REGISTRATION

Registrations must be entered by each individual player to the organizer no later than June 30th 2024 using the entry form below:

Registration – NETU Parkinson Table Tennis Championships 2024

The organizer must be advised of any changes, substitutions or cancellations no later than August 1st 2024 after which no changes or substitutions of players will be allowed. Hotel/hospitality cancellation will be permitted until August 1st 2024 and 100% refundable. All cancellations after this date will not be refunded.

Copy of a valid passport, photograph and the medical certificate of each participant must be sent to the organizer together with the entry form.

Note: The NETU Parkinson Table Tennis Championships will have a maximum number of participants (88). Please be aware that we will implement the "first come first served" principal. After this number has been reached registration will close.

SYSTEM OF PLAY

All events use the standard group stage and playoff stage format of play with groups of 3-4 players. Group winners and runners up will qualify for the playoff stage. Players who don't qualify in singles events will play one consolation round.

All matches are played in best out of five games to eleven.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment and materials are provided by STIGA.

HOSPITALITY

Official Hotel Partner of the 2024 NETU Parkinson Table Tennis Championships is Clarion Hotel the Pier.

TRANSPORTATION

Shuttles will be provided between Gothenburg Central Station and the official hotel at arrival and departure upon request.

DEADLINES

June 30th 2024 – Final date of registration.

August 1st 2024 – Final date of payment of fees as well as notification of changes, substitutions or cancellations.

ENTRY FEE &

Entry fee and official hospitality package – €300

HOSPITALITY PACKAGE

The fee includes all meals starting from dinner on check-in date to lunch on check-out date. Breakfast will be served at the hotel.

Delegates/accompanying persons – €275

Entry fee for players includes:

- Entry to all singles and doubles events
- 2 nights at hotel in double room
- Catering during tournament including formal get together dinner Saturday evening
- Shuttle service from Gothenburg Central Station upon request

Single room extra fee €50

Invoice must be paid to STTA no later than August 1st for the registration to be valid.

PRIZES & AWARDS

Medals for all winners, finalists and semi finalists in all events.

PLAYER INFORMATION

All registered federations, delegations, pairings and players agree to all matches being the object of television broadcast, internet webcasting, photographic coverage and similar activities used to promote the tournament and any related STTA activities.
